Get Ready for A Phenomenon of Light and Colour Shows and Amazing Thailand Countdown 2024

Till 31 December 2023, visitors are welcome to immerse themselves in the nightly extravagant light shows **Vijit Chao Phraya 2023** at the five locations or across from each venue on the opposite side of the river. Locations include *Rama VIII Bridge, Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn), Wichai Prasit Fort, Memorial Bridge (Phra Phuttha Yodfa Bridge) and River City Bangkok.*

Along both sides of the Chao Phraya River, stretching from Rama III Bridge to Rama VIII Bridge, other landmarks including ICONSIAM, Asiatique the Riverfront Destination, Lhong 1919, the Royal Thai Navy Headquarters, and the Bank of Thailand Museum also joining in the light up activities at their venues.

On 31 December, the Vijit Chao Phraya 2023 event will culminate in the Amazing Thailand Countdown 2024 with main activities scheduled at Wat Arun.

'Songkran in Thailand' declared an UNESCO 'intangible cultural heritage'



Songkran in Thailand, Traditional Thai New Year Festival" has been included in the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO).

The recognition follows the inclusion of "Khon" in 2018, "Nuat Thai" in 2019, and "Nora" in 2021.


For tourists, the Songkran Festival offers a chance to enjoy a huge celebration where water parties break out in the streets of Thailand's towns and villages. For the locals, it is a time when they can spend precious time with their families and visit temples to observe ancient rites and make merit.

Songkran is officially observed as a three-day national holiday from 13-15 April, although celebrations can go on for longer – up to a week in some places.

Chiang Rai and Suphan Buri join UNESCO Creative Cities' list

UNESCO named Chiang Rai as the City of Design and Suphan Buri as the City of Music, confirming the innate values of both destinations.

Thailand now has 5 cities on this prestigious list: Phuket and Phetchaburi as the Cities of Gastronomy, Chiang Mai and Sukhothai as the Cities of Crafts and Folk Art, and Bangkok as the City of Design.
